New Business

- **Treasurer update**
 - Casino Account \$ 29,261.27
 - *Chair is to confirm if this needs to be used by the end of the year
 - Regular Account \$ 18,106.66
 - \$480 check needed to go into the account from the Lacross game
- **Old Business**
 - Fundraisers for the year as previously discussed in June:
