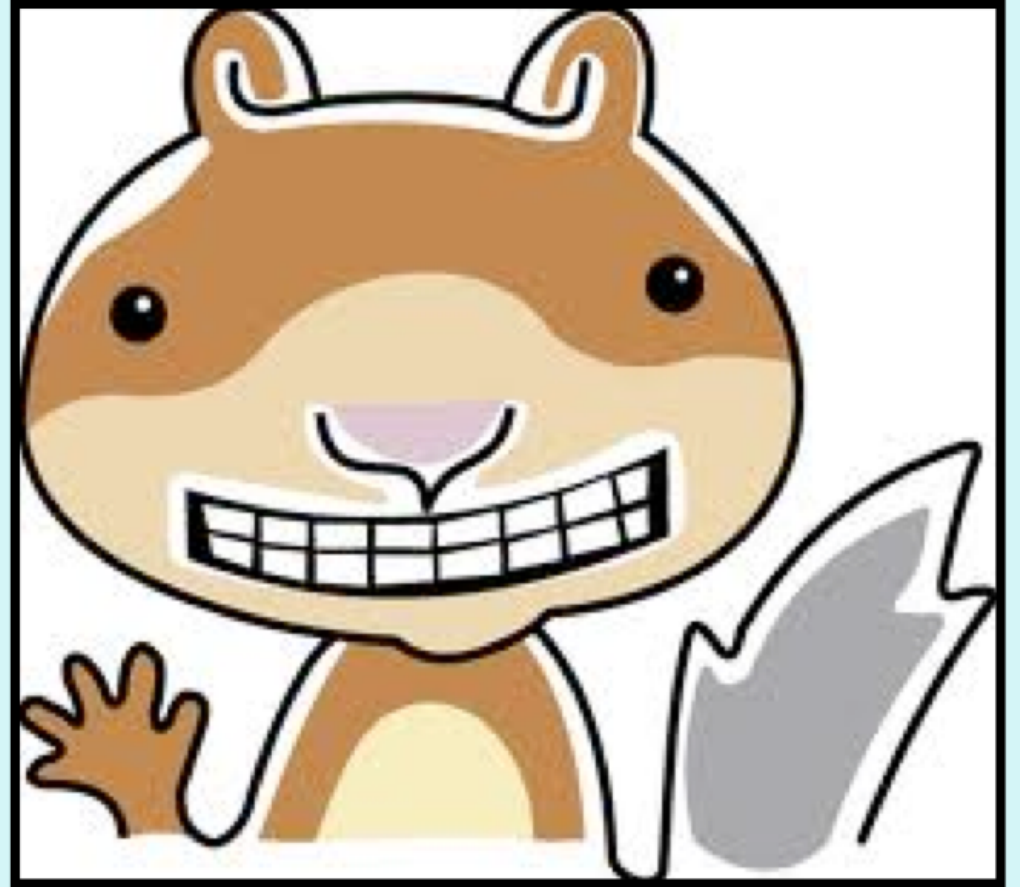

## PURPOSE OF HOME READING

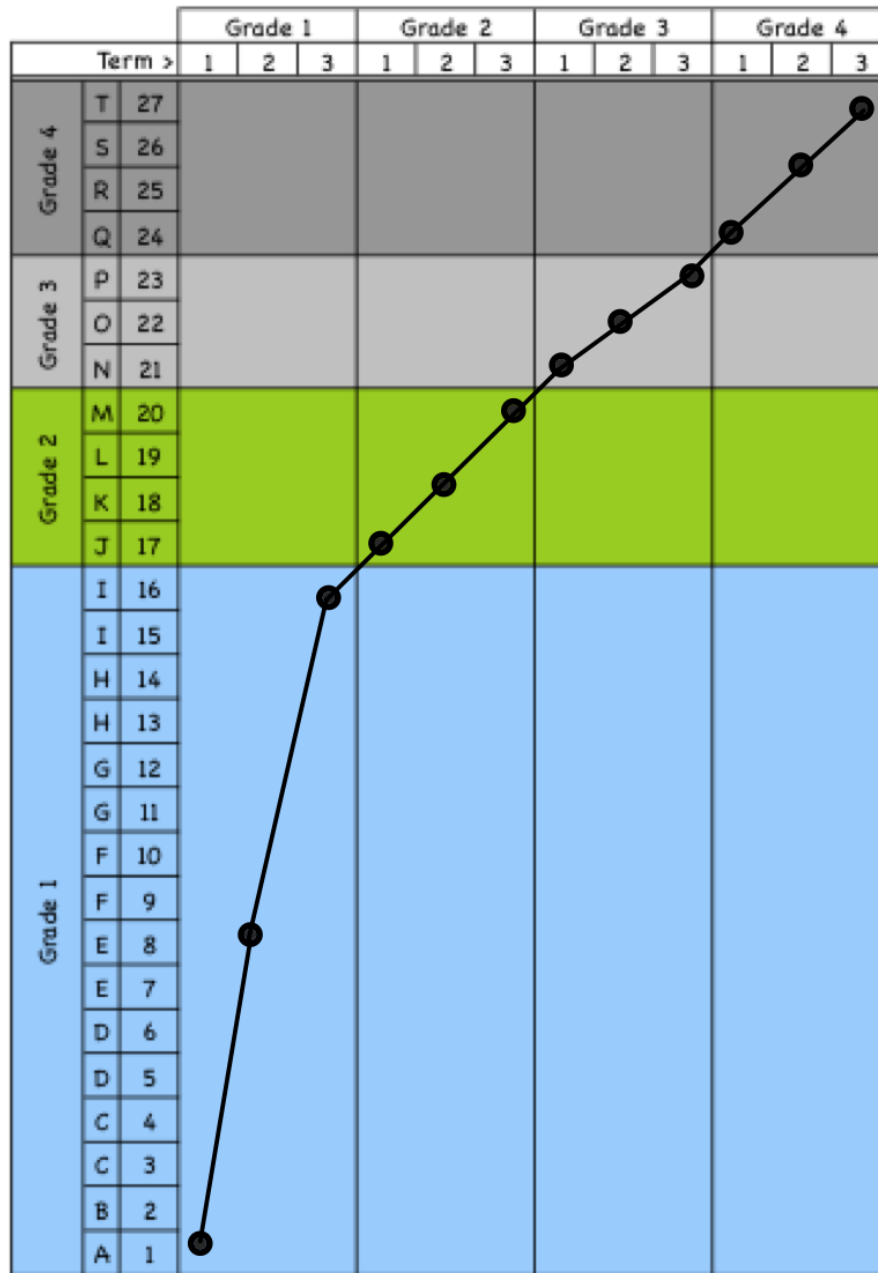
- ❖ Have fun

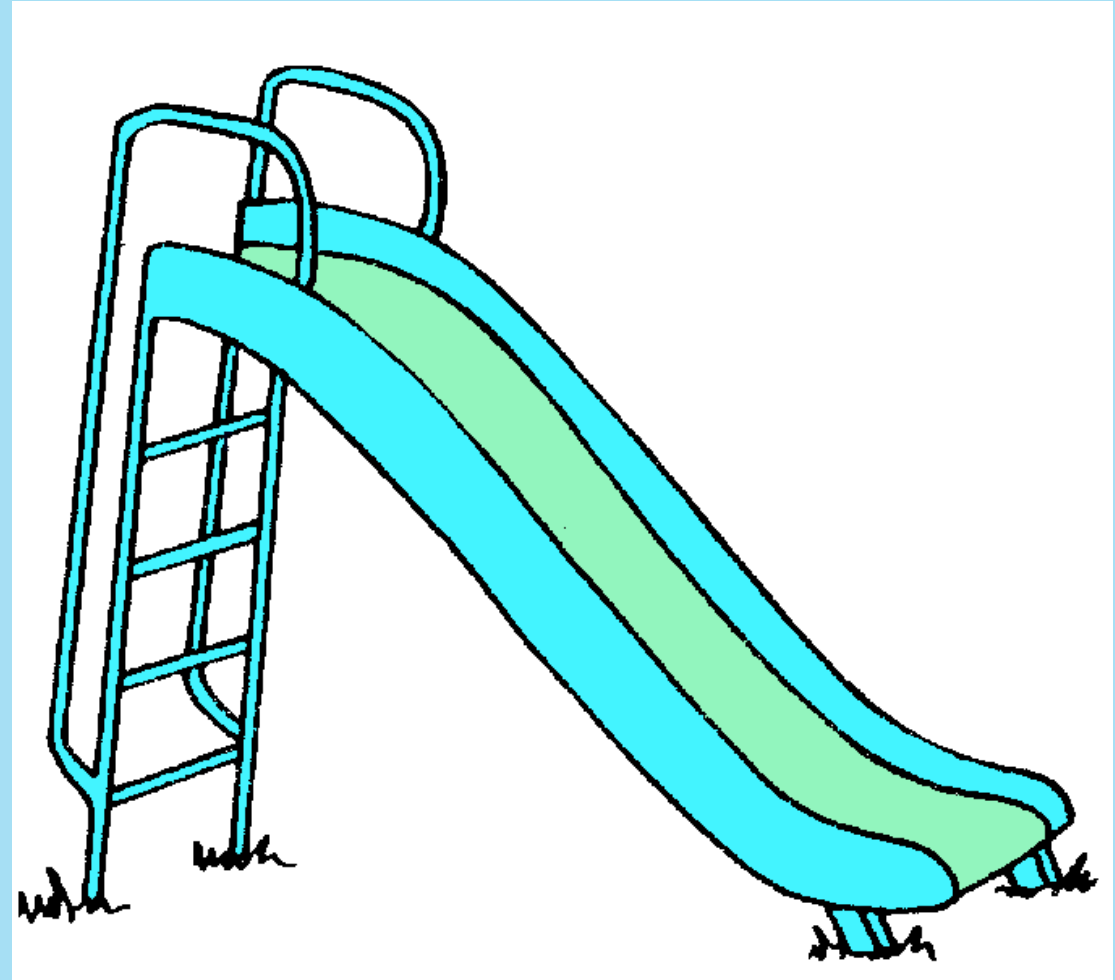


# Instructional Reading Levels Chart

# ITS OKAY!

Your child may not start off at the same level they left off at in grade one!

- We place a significant emphasis on comprehension
- It was a long summer and students need time to practice their skills.



# DECODING STRATEGIES

- Look at the picture
- Look for chunks
- Think about what makes sense
- Skip and go back



# COMPREHENSION STRATEGIES

- As the levels increase the focus shifts to comprehension, less on decoding strategies
- We expect deep comprehension for fiction and non-fiction books
- There is a shift from learning to read, to reading to learn.





# COMPREHENSION STRATEGIES

- Picture walk (predict)
- Talk while you are reading (don't wait until the end of the book)
- Share connections (this reminds me of..)
- Share background knowledge (I know that...)
- Only developed when decoding is secure

- Phrasing
- Attending to punctuation
- Intonation and expression

# SIGHT WORDS

- ❖ Strong correlation between home reading and sight word level
- ❖ Practice nightly for 2 minutes



# GUIDED READING

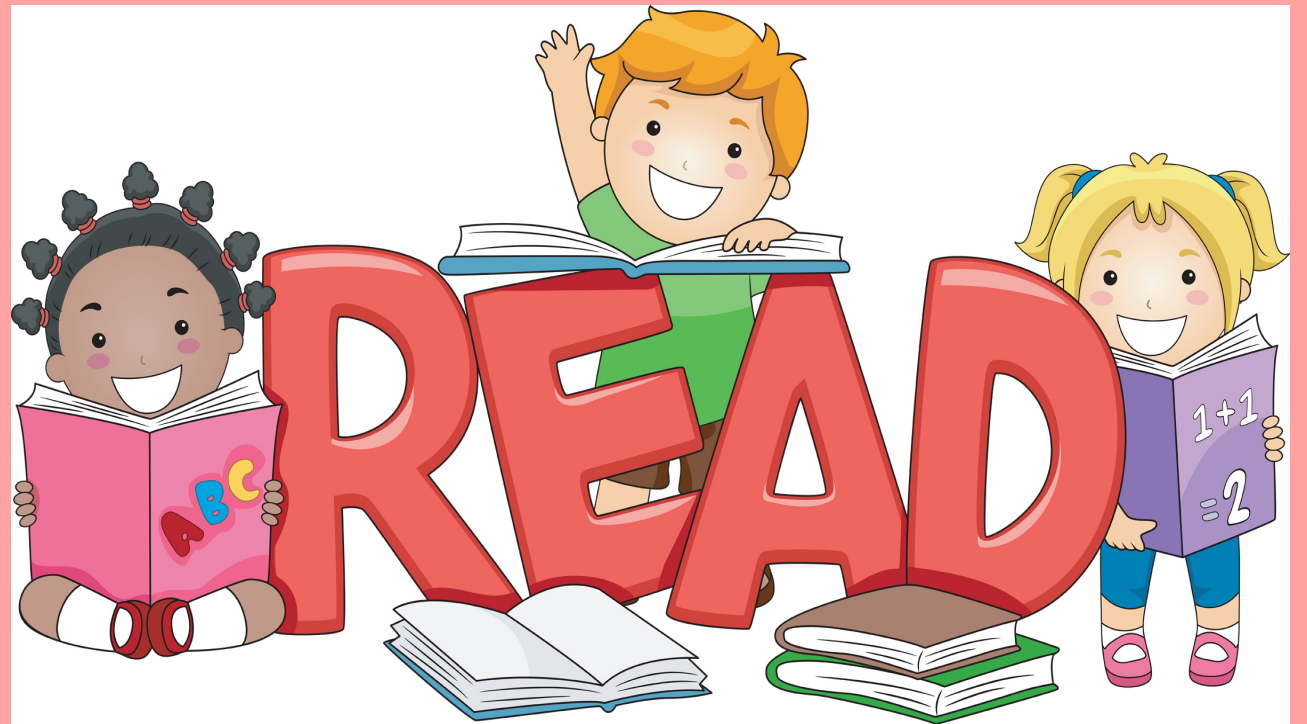
Students read in a small group with their teacher at their instructional level



# WHAT SHOULD HOME READING LOOK LIKE?

- ❖ Read out loud
- ❖ 15-20 minutes every night
- ❖ Time to enjoy with your child

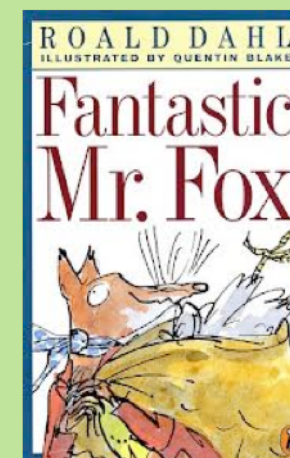
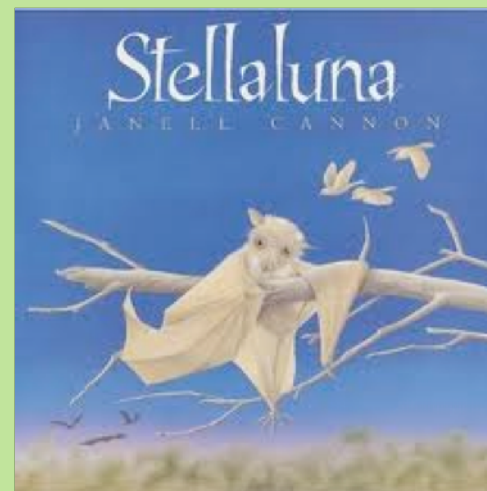
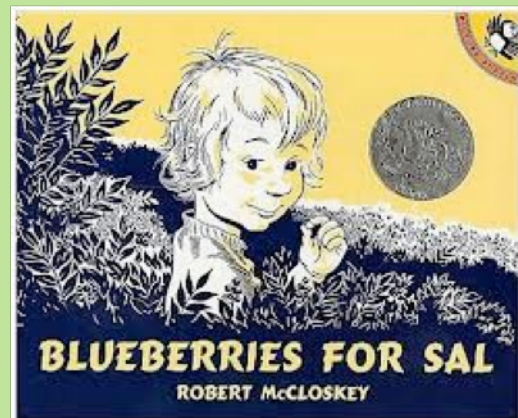
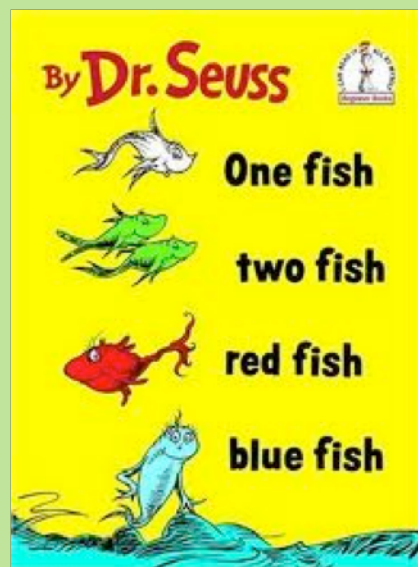
# RAZ KIDS

- Weekly reports



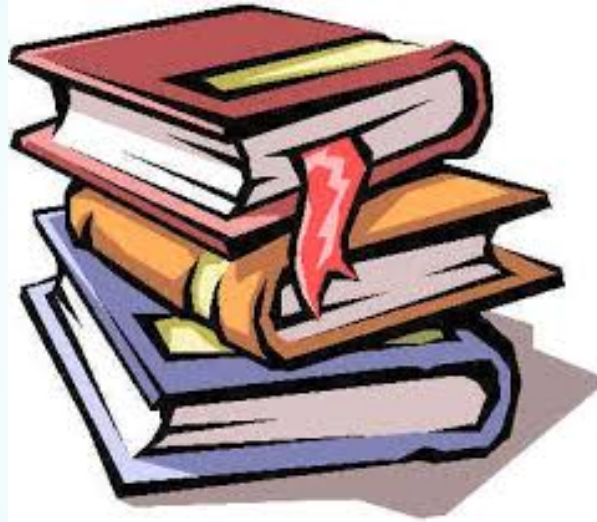
